Course Overview

The Access to HE Healthcare profession allows students to develop their skills in preparation for progression to university, students who successfully complete this course progress to study:

- Nursing
- Midwifery
- Mental Health Nursing

This is a fully online course, where you can access the course materials and assessments 24 hours a day. You will be fully supported throughout your course with online 1:1 tutorials and group tutorials.

What You Will Study

Throughout this course you will study a range of different subject areas including, Biology, Psychology and Health related studies. Some of the units that you will study are:

Attendance Expectations
