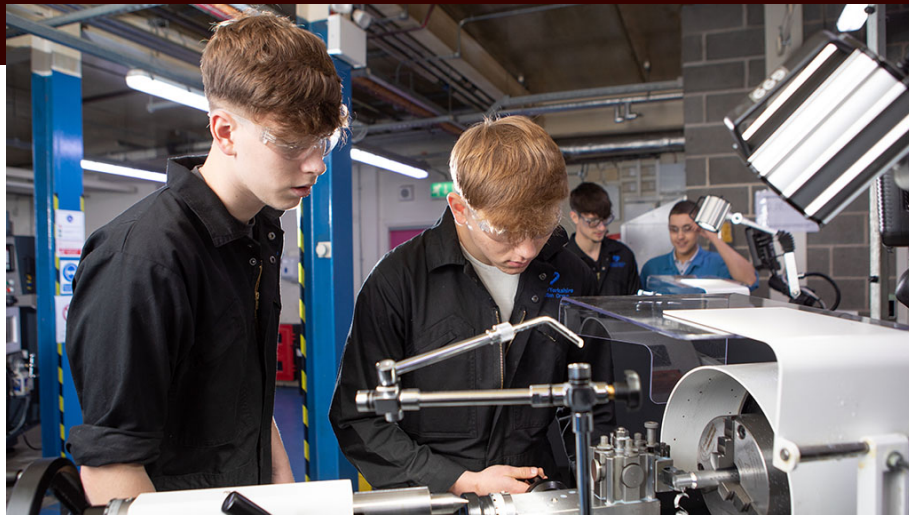


Level 2 Engineering Operation Skills (Mechatronics)
