What You Will Study

Entry Requirements

4 GCSEs at Grade 9-4, including English or Maths and a Grade 3 in either English or Maths.

OR

4 GCSEs at Grade 9-4 including English or Maths and a Level 2 in either English or Maths.

OR

Successful completion of Level 2 at Merit Grade and GCSE English or Maths at Grade 4 and Level 2 English or Maths.

PLUS

Satisfactory interview/audition or submission of music production/compositions.

Please email an example of a recording or production to sthornley@heartofyorkshire.ac.uk prior to your interview. Your example should demonstrate the use of music technology. When you attend your interview, please bring along your latest school report, and your predicted grades.
