Course Overview

The UK's Public Services sector is one of the largest employers in the country. It works to develop and implement government policies and helps deliver a huge range of services. Life in the public services can be challenging, rewarding, interesting, exciting and you will require a variety of skills, knowledge, and expertise to succeed. This course/programme will help you develop all these qualities and give you an introduction to careers within this sector, whilst providing you with many other attributes such as communication and leadership, teamworking skills and confidence, which are vitally important in all uniformed public service roles.
